Dress Code for School Dances

Attire for Girls:

Casual Dances

Dress is a dress or a blouse with pants, skirt or shorts. Jeans are permitted but must not have holes or be frayed at the hem.

Blouses or tops must not have immodest neckline (based on girl's body type), visible midriff, cut outs, or backs lower than the traditional bra line.

Any printing or embellishments on your shirt must be of an appropriate nature.

Immodest hip hugger pants, skirts, or shorts are not permitted.

Hemlines and slits in skirts or dresses must be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee.

Dresses may not be skin-tight spandex or knit.

Shorts must be of an appropriate length.

Girls must wear dress shoes, casual sandals, or tennis shoes.

No pierced body parts are to be visible except the ear lobes

No tattoos are to be visible.

No one may enter the dance with props, canes, knapsacks, book bags, or glow sticks.

Semi Formal Dances

You may wear a short or long dress that is modest and fits appropriately.

Hemlines and slits in dresses or skirts must be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee.

Dresses must not have immodest low necklines (based on girl's body type), visible midriffs, cut-outs or backs lower than the traditional bra line.

Strapless dresses are permissible if they are modest.

Dresses may not be skin-tight spandex or knit

Jackets, sweaters, or any other outer garment may not be used to cover an inappropriate dress.

Girls must wear dress shoes only.

No pierced body parts are to be visible except the ear lobes

No tattoos are to be visible.

No one may enter the dance with props, canes, knapsacks, book bags, or glow sticks.

Prom

Dress is formal. Dresses must be long, floor length.

Slits in dresses must be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee.

Dresses must not have immodest low necklines (based on girl's body type), visible midriffs, cut-outs or backs lower than the traditional bra line.

Strapless dresses are permissible if they are modest.

Dresses may not be skin-tight spandex or knit

Jackets, sweaters, or any other outer garment may not be used to cover an inappropriate dress.

Girls must wear dress shoes only.

No pierced body parts are to be visible except the ear lobes

No tattoos are to be visible.

No one may enter the dance with props, canes, knapsacks, book bags, or glow sticks.

The administration and faculty of Archbishop Rummel High School will make all final judgments on the appropriateness of questionable attire. Anyone who does not adhere to these guidelines will call their parents and not be admitted to the dance.

Dress Code for School Dances

Attire for Boys:

Casual Dances

Your shoulders must be covered; you may not wear muscle shirts or tank tops.

You may wear neat collared shirts or T-Shirts.

Any printing or embellishments on your shirt must be of an appropriate nature.

You may wear casual pants, neat jeans, or shorts. Jeans must not have holes in them or frayed at the hems.

Your shorts must be of an appropriate length. Running shorts or workout shorts are not permitted.

Your clothing must fit. Oversized shirts or pants are not permitted.

Your pants must be worn at an appropriate level to the waist.

You may wear casual shoes and socks or tennis shoes and socks.

No headwear of any kind is permitted.

All grooming rules as stated in the handbook must be followed.

No one may enter the dance with props, canes, knapsacks, book bags, or glow sticks.

Semiformal School Dances

Dress is a coat, a conventional dress shirt, a tie, plain dress slacks (a dark color, gray, or khaki), belt, dress shoes, and socks.

A suit may be substituted for sports coat and slacks.

Shirts must be kept tucked in and ties must be worn throughout the duration of the dance.

No headwear of any kind is permitted.

All grooming rules as stated in the handbook must be followed.

No one may enter the dance with props, canes, knapsacks, book bags, or glow sticks.

Prom

Dress is a conservative tuxedo (black, gray, white, or dark blue) with dress shoes and dark socks.

Tuxedos may have tails

Shirts must be kept tucked in and ties must be worn throughout the duration of the dance.

Top hats and canes are not allowed.

All grooming rules as stated in the handbook must be followed.

No one may enter the dance with props, canes, knapsacks, book bags, or glow sticks.
