### ***ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME INDUCTS NEW MEMBERS AT RUMMEL EVENT***

Three alumni and a former coach were recently inducted into the Athletic Hall of Fame at Archbishop Rummel High School.

The alums are Darrin Dares, '86; Pat Kennedy, '83; James Bullinger, '83; and former coach Pete Fenner.

The induction began in the Raider Room on campus where the honorees were introduced by Phil Greco, athletic director, and each addressed former inductees, alumni and friends in attendance.

The formal induction occurred on the Yenni Stadium turf before the start of the Archbishop Rummel-Jesuit football game. All four honorees were presented plaques by Michael Begg, president. Congratulating them on the field were Michael Scalco, principal, and Greco.



“We honor those persons who have been instrumental in the great success our athletic program has enjoyed over the years,” said Greco.

Darrin Dares was a four sport letterman in football, basketball, baseball, and track. Pat Kennedy lettered in football and track for the Raiders, while James Bullinger was a baseball letterman.

Former coach Pete Fenner has held several coaching positions at the school, including assistant football and baseball coach and golf coach.

The Athletic Hall of Fame at Archbishop Rummel began in 1997 and has inducted several new members every year, said Greco.
