Archbishop Rummel High School would like to offer your son the opportunity to be more prepared for the upcoming school year.

The **Summer Foundations Program**, an integral part of our school for many years, helps students ease their transition into the high school environment, familiarize themselves with our campus, and get a “jump start” on the basic skills needed to ensure a successful beginning to their high school years.

**Summer Foundations** offers classes in the core subjects of Math, Reading, and English, as well as Religion. Please understand that these courses do not replace traditional summer school if your son has failed a course in the 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade.

**Summer Foundations** also offers a course in Study Skills, which is aimed at students who need help with organization, time management, and better ways to study. Faculty members dedicated to the mission of Archbishop Rummel High School and the success of our students teach all of our classes.

Parents and students have reported to us that participation in **Summer Foundations** prepared students for the transition between elementary and high school, giving them a definite edge as they move into the secondary school environment.

You can decide if your son should enroll in **Summer Foundations** by evaluating the following:

- *His standardized test scores from elementary school*
- *His report card grades for the past two years*
- *His score on the recent High School Placement Test*

Please consider **Summer Foundations** if your son needs to improve his grades in the core subjects. Also, if his scores in Science or Social Studies need improvement, or if he would like to be more prepared for the upcoming school year, then please sign him up for Study Skills. Please know that Archbishop Rummel High School is seeking a partnership with you so that together we can provide your son with the finest education available.

General Information:

- Registration / Scheduling      Friday, May 30                      8 AM – Noon
  - (Registration may close because class sizes are limited.)
- Registration and all classes will be held at the Archbishop Rummel Junior High School campus (2000 N. Arnoult, at the corner of 39<sup>th</sup> St.)
- Classes begin Monday, June 2. Classes end Friday, June 27.
- Courses are open to all current Archbishop Rummel 8<sup>th</sup> graders and all incoming 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade students who have already registered at Archbishop Rummel High School.
- Course offerings:
  - **Math:** Grade 7 Review, Grade 8 Pre-Algebra Review
  - **Reading:** Includes individualized reading assessment
  - **English:** Grade 7 Review, Grade 8 Review
  - **Religion:** Preparing for High School
  - **Study Skills for Jr. High / High School:** Orients students to the world of junior/senior high academics and study, school activities, student responsibilities, etc.
- Classes will start at 8:00 AM, Monday through Friday. Each class will last 85 minutes.
- Students may take as many as five courses total, but only three per session.
- Pre-registration deadline is May 29. Pre-registration fee is \$60 (non-refundable) per student. After May 29, the registration fee will be \$75 per student. Call 834-5592, ext. 251 to confirm pre-registration.
- **Course Fee:** \$150.00 for each course
- **Special Information:**
  - Students must provide their own transportation.
  - Registration will take place in Room 301 on the Junior High Campus on May 30th.
  - Tuition is payable, in full, by check or cash on the day of registration and is non-refundable after the first day of class.
- Further information about rules, regulations, and class times will be distributed during registration.
