
Price: The original download is free, but that only comes with a handful of questions. To get the *real* prep, you'll need to do some in-app purchasing. The full version of their ACT test bank, with over 1000 questions, is \$4.99.

Key Features:

- Tracks your strengths and weaknesses so you can focus your studying
- Adapts questions based on your performance
- Gives you the ability to mark questions for future use or retake only questions you've flagged
- Offers the ability to choose questions from all multiple-choice subject areas (English, Math, Reading, Science Reasoning) or a combination of a couple or just one.
- Gives you test tips and strategies while you go, so if you keep missing questions that test a particular skill, for example, you'll get a tip that tells you how to improve.
- Compares your skills with others' statistics, so you get a feel for the percentile in which you're testing.
