This morning, please remember in our prayers, **Father Wayne Roca**, beloved chaplain of Archbishop Rummel High School, on the anniversary of his death, 12/6/1999.

Bishop, prisoner for the faith, unafraid of knocking out a heretic, Saint Nicholas of Myra has been remembered by history as Santa Claus in part because he gave his wealth to the poor and when he heard of a father about to sell his daughters into prostitution because of their poverty he dropped a bag of money down the chimney at night so he could pay the dowry and have his daughters married. A staunch defender of the Faith, Nicholas would be imprisoned by the Romans to be freed when Constantine became Emperor. At the Council of Nicaea in 325 Nicholas would get into an argument with the heretic Arius before punching him in the face. For this Nicholas was stripped of his mitre and book of the Gospels, the signs of his office as a bishop, and was thrown in prison. That evening Our Lord appeared to Nicholas and returned his mitre and book of the Gospels. When the guards saw Nicholas with the things of his office in his jail cell he was immediately released. Saint Nicholas...pray for us.

O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer You my prayers, works, joys, and sufferings of this day for all the intentions of Your Sacred Heart, in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world, in reparation for my sins, for the intentions of our bishops, and in particular for the intentions of the Holy Father.
