

## Project Prom Information

*Please read this information before you arrive at the Project Prom Event. If you have any questions, please contact Ms. Otilio.*

1. Before arriving at the gym, change into comfortable clothing. Project Prom T-Shirt and shorts or something comparable would be a good choice for the night. Please pass along this information regarding dress to your date. Also, remind her **not to bring a large purse into the event.**
