JAY ROTH *Head Coach*

A 1981 graduate of Archbishop Rummel, Coach Roth completed his 22nd year as Head Coach of the Raider Football Team. The 22 year veteran coach of the Raiders sports an impressive list of achievements including 2012 and 2013 5A State Championships, nine (9) trips to the state semi-finals, seven (7) undefeated regular seasons, twelve (12) Catholic League Championships, and an overall 213-54 record. Additionally, Roth was named District Coach of the Year twelve (12) times and Louisiana Coach of the Year twice.

Having taken his Raiders to the state play-offs for 21 out of his 22 years at the helm, Roth has a notable 41-19 win-loss record in post season competitions.

Over 65 of his Archbishop Rummel players have advanced to play college ball during his tenure as head coach and two of his former athletes have played in the National Football League.

During his playing days at Rummel (1978-1981), Coach Roth was a three year letterman at quarterback, leading the Raiders to their first undefeated season in 1980. A 1985 graduate of Nicholls State University, Roth was a four year letterman on the football team and 1985 team captain. Prior to his present position at Rummel, Roth coached three years at each

Jesuit and Archbishop Shaw. He also spent a year at East Ascension and East Jefferson.

For the Raiders, Coach Roth is also Offensive Coordinator and Quarterback/ Running Backs coach. He teaches Physical Education. He and his wife Karen live in Jefferson with their son Craig.



With 34 years on the Archbishop Rummel faculty, Coach Boh is certainly a veteran member of the coaching staff. A graduate of the University of Louisiana, Lafayette, he teaches American History, and Physical Education to his students. Prior to Archbishop Rummel, he taught at St. Stanislaus in Bay St. Louis, Mississippi, and Cathedral Carmel in Lafayette, Louisiana. Coach Boh is responsible for the Defensive Line for the Raiders. He and his wife Mary have six children, twelve grandchildren and number 13 is due in November. Sons Brian ('94) and Kevin ('96) are graduates of Rummel.

BOBBY SANDERS

In his second stint here at Archbishop Rummel, Bobby Sanders will be the passing game coordinator and receiver coach. Bobby is a 1997 graduate of Archbishop Rummel where he was an All-District tight end for the Raiders. He is a graduate of Holy Cross College with a degree in Marketing. Coach Sanders is entering his 13th year of coaching, which include 6 at Archbishop Rummel, 5 at Lakeshore High, and 1 at De La Salle. Cordae Hankton is entering his 6th season on the Raider coaching staff in charge of coaching linebackers. After his graduation, he received a scholarship to Jackson State University. Beginning his 13th season at Archbishop Rummel, Nick Monica will coordinate the defense and serve as the special teams coordinator. Nick is also beginning his 8th season as head baseball coach. Kerrie has been a Mathematics teacher at Archbishop Rummel for the last 11 years. She continues to serve as the Academic Advisor for the football team. In addition, she is also Student Council Moderator and Homecoming Court Coordinator. Kerrie is a 1991 graduate of Archbishop Chapelle High School where she was a member and president of the Chapellette Dance Team. Prior to joining the Rummel faculty, she was a teacher at Ursuline Academy for 3 years and Archbishop Chapelle High School for 4 years. While at Chapelle, she was the

Director of the Chapellette Dance Team. She graduated from the University of New Orleans with a Bachelor of Science in Secondary Math Education. Kerrie and her husband Mark reside in Metairie with their daughter Morgan and their son Luke.

BRETT WRIGHT

Returning for a 3rd season as a volunteer coach, Brett works to help develop the Raiders' punting and kicking talent. A graduate of Southeastern Louisiana University, he punted three seasons ('81-'83) for the Lions and finished a collegiate career with a 42.2 yard average. Earning All-American honors after his senior season led to an eighth round selection by New York Jets during the 1984 NFL Draft. He is employed as a process operator with over 27 years of service at the Shell facility in Norco. Brett and his wife Erin live in Metairie with their children Madeline, Nicholas, and Gabriel.

MICHAEL KENNEDY

Coach Michael Kennedy is entering his first season on the Rummel Raider coaching staff, and will be coaching cornerbacks. Coach Kennedy is a 2013 honor graduate of Archbishop Rummel. He was a captain on the 2012 5A State Championship team, and was an all-district and all-metro linebacker his senior season. Coach Kennedy previously coached at University Laboratory High School for three years, where he was a defensive assistant on the 2014 Division 2 State Championship team. He recently graduated Louisiana State University in 2017 and will be teaching Biology this year.

GRAHAM JARROTT

Jarrott begins his first year at Archbishop Rummel High School as the offensive line coach. Jarrott has coached at Jesuit for the last eight seasons from 2009-2017 as the Offensive line Coach (2009-2104) and Offensive Coordinator (2015-2017). Prior to Jesuit he served as the offensive coordinator at DeLaSalle for the 2007 and 2008 campaigns. Prior to his two-year stint at DeLaSalle, Jarrott coached the offensive line at Brother Martin from 2003-2006. A graduate of Nicholls State University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in General Studies, Jarrott played four years on the offensive line from 1999-2003. Jarrott will teach World History and Physical Education. He and his wife, Cheryl reside in Metairie.

JOSEPH HOLT

This is Coach Joey's first year on the Archbishop Rummel Football Staff as the Assistant Offensive Line Coach. A 2016 honors graduate from Rummel, Joey was a three-year letterman, two-time state champion in football, as well as a one-year letterman in wrestling. In his years at Rummel, Joey was also involved in Student Council, Ambassadors, and Eucharistic Ministers.
