

# **DUAL ENROLLMENT**

n cooperation with Southeastern Louisiana University and the University of New Orleans, Archbishop Rummel High School students complete college-level courses. These courses are taught by Archbishop Rummel High School teachers on the Archbishop Rummel High School campus, in partnership with Southeastern Louisiana University and University of New Orleans professors.

The students earn both high school and college credit that goes on the Archbishop Rummel High School transcript and on a college transcript.

The credit is transferrable to all public universities and colleges in the state of Louisiana and to many other colleges including private universities in Louisiana.
