Scheduling

- course requests

- device pickup in August

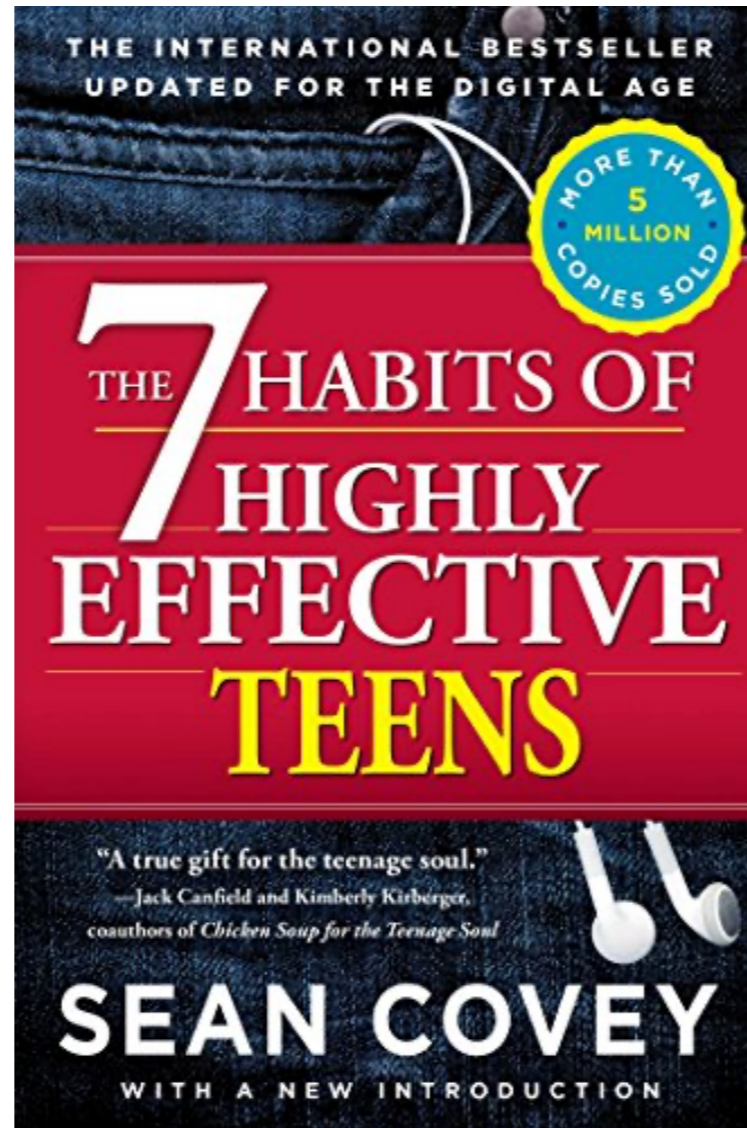
