Student ChromeBooks

- ❖ property of the school
- ❖ protective sleeve given this week during Theology class
- ❖ chargers **NOT ALLOWED** on campus
- ❖ device must be have enough power to last the school day
- ❖ teacher determines when and how device used in class
- ❖ failure to follow instructions = discipline challenge

Canvas

- ❖ Learning Management System
- ❖ allows students to see:
 - ❖ grades
 - ❖ homework
 - ❖ posted lecture notes
 - ❖ class announcements
- ❖ allows students to submit assignments online
- ❖ allows students to take online assessments
 - ❖ quizzes
 - ❖ tests

FACTS

- ❖ Learning Management System
- ❖ allows parents to see:
 - ❖ grades
 - ❖ homework
 - ❖ daily progress reports
 - ❖ report cards

Canvas vs. FACTS

- ❖ Canvas used by students ONLY (parents DO NOT have Canvas accounts)
- ❖ FACTS used by parents ONLY (students DO NOT have FACTS accounts)
- ❖ two programs sync at 4:00 p.m.

Missed Work

- ❖ school policy to place a zero (0) for any assignment not submitted when due
- ❖ parent receives email from FACTS if student receives a zero (0) for a particular assignment
- ❖ make up policy for absences ONLY
 - ❖ homework, classwork, and quizzes:
 - ❖ If the student was present the day the assignment was given, then the assignment is due the day the student returns to school.
 - ❖ If the student was absent the day the assignment was given, then the student receives the day he returns plus one more school day to submit the assignment.
 - ❖ tests, projects, papers:
 - ❖ If the student was present the day before the assessment, then the student takes the assessment the day he returns to school.
 - ❖ If the student missed the day before the assessment, then the student has five (5) days to make up the assessment and still receive full credit. If the student does not take the assessment within five (5) days, then the highest grade that he can earn is 69%.
- ❖ extenuating circumstances determined by school counselor

MathXL for School

- ❖ online math curriculum
- ❖ no physical textbook
- ❖ access to “textbook” within program
- ❖ shift in traditional math grading
 - ❖ no longer do students receive homework grade based on effort
 - ❖ homework grade now based on correctness
 - ❖ unlimited chances to obtain correct answer
- ❖ math teachers available to help

Textbooks

- ❖ delivered through Canvas
- ❖ delivered through Savvas (teachers give student instructions)
- ❖ purchased through MBS Direct

Academic Learning Session

- ❖ 25 minutes each day
- ❖ incorporated into the class before lunch
- ❖ allows students the opportunity to work on assignments
- ❖ allows students the opportunity to study for an upcoming assessment
- ❖ allows students the opportunity to seek extra help from teachers
- ❖ not a time for socializing, game playing, sleeping

Semester Exams

- ❖ one continuous grading period from August through December
- ❖ one continuous grading period from January through May
- ❖ semester exam worth 25% of semester grade
- ❖ exam format and expectations given to students by individual teachers
- ❖ exams for ALL courses (including PE, ACT Prep, etc.)

Summer School

At the end of the first semester, if a student's semester 1 grade is below 70%, then the student will be required to attend summer school to remediate the failing grade.

At the end of the second semester, if a student's semester 2 grade is below 70%, then the student will be required to attend summer school to remediate the failing grade.

If a student fails three courses in a semester, then he is not eligible to return for the following school year.
