Dear Parents and Guardians of New Students:

The Archdiocesan Finance Council approved the following tuition and fees for the 2023-2024 academic year:

The 2023-24 registration fee MAY NOT BE FINANCED in a tuition loan.

Registration Fee \$ 350 Due March 23, 2023

The 2023-24 new student technology device fee MAY NOT BE FINANCED in a tuition loan.

New Student Technology Device Fee \$ 300 Due May 1, 2023 (Device is provided by the school.)

The Tuition, Building Fee and Student Fee Bill for 2023-24 may be financed in a tuition loan.

The Student Fee Bill covers expenses related to technology, library resources, retreats, parent club, and student agendas. While the registration fee is due by March 23, and the new student technology device fee is due by May 1, 2023, only the tuition, building fee, and student fee bill can be included in a loan. Information regarding online payments and execution of tuition loans is enclosed and also can be found online at www.rummelraiders.com.

All incoming students for the 2023-2024 school year must register online. Online registration will open on Wednesday, March 1, 2023. A link to the registration website is located at www.rummelraiders.com. This simple process allows you to pay your 2023-2024 non-refundable registration fee. Registration will be considered late if paid after March 23, 2023. A \$200 late fee will be assessed which will increase incrementally each month thereafter.

Once you have completed the registration process, you will be able to apply for financial aid. However, there is a limited amount of financial aid for the 2023-2024 school year. Only families verified to have extreme financial hardships will be considered for an award. The deadline to apply for financial aid is March 31, 2023.
