Bishop, prisoner for the faith, unafraid of knocking out a heretic, Saint Nicholas of Myra has been remembered by history as Santa Claus in part because he gave his wealth to the poor and when he heard of a father about to sell his daughters into prostitution because of their poverty he dropped a bag of money down the chimney at night so he could pay the dowry and have his daughters married. A staunch defender of the Faith, Nicholas would be imprisoned by the Ro-mans to be freed when Constantine became Emperor. At the Council of Nicaea in 325 Nicholas would get into an argument with the heretic Arius before punching him in the face. For this Nicholas was stripped of his mitre and book of the Gospels, the signs of his office as a bishop, and was thrown in prison. That evening Our Lord appeared to Nicholas and returned his mitre and book of the Gospels. When the guards saw Nicholas with the sings of his office in his jail cell he was immediately released. Saint Nicholas...Pray for us.
