

## **Archbishop Rummel High School Dress Code for School Events**

Archbishop Rummel students and all guests should dress modestly for all events and dances. Students are required to meet all grooming standards set forth in the Student Handbook.

Below are specific requirements for events sponsored by Archbishop Rummel High School:

### **Rummel/Chapelle BBQ, Back to School Dance**

#### **Boys Dress:**

- No muscle shirts or tank tops
- Neat collared shirts or T-shirts are allowed
- All printing or embellishments on shirts must be of an appropriate nature. (For example, wording, pictures, drawings, or photos that are drug, tobacco, or alcohol related are not permitted. Also, any wording, pictures, or drawings that are vulgar and/or profane are not allowed.)
- Casual pants, neat jeans, or shorts are allowed. Jeans must not have holes or frays at the hems.
- Shorts must be an appropriate length.
- Oversized shirts or pants are not permitted, and pants must be worn at the waist.
- Casual shoes and socks or tennis shoes and socks are allowed.
- Flip-flops, backless sandals, crocs, slides or slippers are not allowed.

#### **Girls Dress:**

- Acceptable attire is a dress or a blouse with pants, skirt, or shorts
- Jeans are permitted but must not have holes or frays
- Blouses or tops must have a modest neckline
- Any printing or embellishments on shirts must be of appropriate nature. (For example, wording, pictures, drawings, or photos that are drug, tobacco, or alcohol related are not permitted. Also, any wording, pictures, or drawings that are vulgar and/or profane are not allowed.)
- No visible midriff or cut outs
- Blouses must cover both shoulders
- Immodest hip hugger pants, skirts, or shorts are not permitted.
- Hemlines and slits in skirts or dresses must be no shorter than two inches above the knee.
- Dresses may not be skin-tight spandex or knit
- Shorts must reach the middle of the thigh (end of the fingers when hands are down at one's side).
- Flip-flops, backless sandals, crocs, slides or slippers are not allowed

## **Ring Dance, Homecoming Dance**

### **Boys Dress:**

- Dress is a plain sports coat, a conventional dress shirt, a necktie, plain dress slacks belt, dress shoes, Tennis shoes/sneakers not allowed
- A conventional suit may be substituted for sports coat and slacks
- Shirts must remain tucked in, and neck ties must be worn throughout the duration of the dance.

### **Girls Dress:**

- Dresses must be long, floor length
- Dresses must be one piece
- Slits in dresses must be no shorter than two inches above the knee
- Dresses must not have immodest low necklines
- No visible midriffs or cut-outs
- No backs lower than the traditional bra line
- The top of the dress can be no lower than the imaginary line drawn across the chest level to the armpits
- If there is a sheer material over the base layer of the dress, the bottom layer must be the same length as the sheer layer
- Strapless dresses are permissible, if they are modest with no cleavage
- Dresses may not be skin-tight spandex or knit
- Jackets, sweaters, or any other outer garment may not be used to cover an inappropriate dress
- Only dress shoes are permitted. Tennis shoes/sneakers not allowed

## **Junior & Senior Prom**

### **Boys Dress:**

- Dress is a conservative tuxedo (black, gray, white, or dark blue) with dress shoes, Tennis shoes/sneakers not allowed
- Tuxedos may have tails, shirts must be tucked in, neck ties must be worn throughout the duration of the dance
- Top hats, canes, or any other props are not allowed

**Girls Dress:** Same dress code listed under Ring Dance and Homecoming Dance

## **Mother-Son Mass, Sports Ceremonies, Senior Breakfast**

- Dress is collared shirt, tucked in, a necktie, dress slacks, dress shoes, Tennis shoes/sneakers not allowed
- No jeans are allowed
- Parents should be similarly attired.

### Student-Parent Meetings, College Night

- Dress is collared shirt, tucked in, dress slacks, dress shoes, and socks, Tennis shoes/sneakers not allowed
- Parents should be similarly attired.

### Full Dress Down Day

- Black or gray plain sweatpants/joggers or Rummel sweatpants, a Rummel t-shirt and sweatshirt, socks, Tennis shoes/sneakers
- Hoodies, hats, flip-flops, backless sandals, crocs, slides or slippers are not allowed

### Regular Dress Down Day

- Rummel t-shirt and sweatshirt, uniform pants, socks, Tennis shoes/sneakers
- Hoodies, hats, flip-flops, backless sandals, crocs, slides or slippers are not allowed

### Rummel/Chapelle Challenge

- If purchased, the Rummel/Chapelle challenge t-shirt (This is the student ticket in.)
- Rummel t-shirt or sweatshirt must be worn, no rival school colors or gear allowed
- Shorts of appropriate length, casual pants, neat jeans. Jeans must not have holes or frays at the hems.
- Tennis shoes/sneakers must be worn
- Hoodies, flip-flops, backless sandals, crocs, slides or slippers are not allowed
- Appropriate costumes and eye black may be worn.
- No face coverings

### Olympic Dress

- Rummel Olympic class t-shirt, uniform pants, socks, Tennis shoes/sneakers
- Hoodies, hats, hoodies, flip-flops, backless sandals, crocs, slides or slippers are not allowed
- Students participating in the Olympic games may change into plain black or gray shorts or Rummel shorts at lunch only.

### Other:

No headwear of any kind is permitted except at the Olympics or the Rummel/Chapelle Challenge. No pierced body parts are to be visible except for one in each lobe and **ONLY** for young women. No tattoos are to be visible. No one may enter the dance with props, including but not limited to the following: canes, knapsacks, book bags, or glow sticks.

The administration and faculty of Archbishop Rummel High School will make all final judgments on the appropriateness of questionable attire. Anyone who does not adhere to these guidelines will call their parents and not be allowed to enter the dance or event.
