Dear Parents and Guardians of Current Students:

The Archdiocesan Finance Council approved the following tuition and fees for the 2019-2020 academic year:

Registration Fee	\$ 300	Due March 18, 2019
Tuition	\$ 8,850	Due May 1, 2019
Building Fee	\$ 700	Due May 1, 2019
Senior Class of 2020 Graduation Fee	\$ 300	Due May 1, 2019
Student Fee Bill	\$ 400	Due August 2019 (Or may be included with tuition loan)

The Student Fee Bill covers expenses related to technology, library resources, retreats and student agendas. While the registration fee is due March 18, the tuition, building, graduation, and student fee bills can all be included in a loan. Information on the execution of tuition loans and on how to pay tuition can be found at www.rummelraiders.com.

All current students who are eligible and intend to return to Archbishop Rummel High School for the 2019-2020 school year must register online. Online registration will begin on Monday, February 25, 2019. A link to the registration website is located at www.rummelraiders.com. This simple process allows you to pay your 2019-2020 non-refundable registration fee. Registration will be considered late if paid after March 18, 2019. A \$200 late fee will be assessed which will increase incrementally each month thereafter.

If you have already financed the 2019-2020 registration fee, you have already received an email notice that no payment is required at this time. If your son is not returning next year, you must inform the school finance office, in writing, no later than March 18, 2019. After this date, any registration fees paid will not be refunded.

Once you have completed the registration process, you will be able to apply for financial aid. However, there is a limited amount of financial aid for the 2019-2020 school year. Only families verified to have an extreme financial hardship will be considered for an award. The deadline to apply for financial aid is March 29, 2019. **All 2018-2019 financial aid recipients must reapply as every student is reassessed annually.** There is no guarantee of award renewal. All student accounts must be current to be considered for a new award. Please visit www.rummelraiders.com to access the link to the Financial Aid Independent Review (FAIR) application.
