Dear Parents and Guardians of Current Students:

Thank you for your intent to enroll your son at Archbishop Rummel High School for the 2025-2026 school year. Except for the graduation fee for all seniors and the annual registration fee for all students, all tuition and fees that are applicable to all have been combined into one tuition amount of \$12,000. Art, AP, and dual enrollment fees remain for those students enrolled in these courses. Information regarding online payments and execution of tuition loans is enclosed and can be found online at www.rummelraiders.com.

FEES

The Archdiocesan Finance Council approved the following tuition and fees for the 2025-2026 academic year:

2025-2026 Registration Fee	\$500	Due March 12, 2025
2025-2026 Tuition	\$12,000	Due May 1, 2025

For your reference, last year's tuition was: \$10,550 with fees of \$700 (building fee), \$450 (student fee bill), for total tuition and fees of \$11,700.

REGISTRATION

All current students who are eligible and intend to return to Archbishop Rummel High School for the 2025-2026 school year must register online. Online registration will open on Wednesday February 12, 2025. A link to the registration website is located at www.rummelraiders.com. This simple process allows you to pay your 2025-2026 non-refundable registration fee. Please understand that timely payment of the registration fee is crucial to your son's expected enrollment. Paying the registration fee on time will save you a late charge and guarantees that your son will be enrolled here next year provided he maintains good academic and disciplinary standing. Registration is considered late if paid after March 12, 2025. A \$200 late fee may be assessed, which may increase incrementally each month thereafter. Please note that your son's enrollment will no longer be reserved after March 12, 2025, if the registration fee has not been paid.

STUDENTS NOT RETURNING

If your son is not returning next year, you must inform the Archbishop Rummel High School Finance Office, in writing, no later than March 12, 2025. A paid registration fee will not be refunded after March 12, 2025.

FINANCIAL AID POSSIBILITIES

Once you complete the registration process, you will be able to apply for financial aid from the school. However, there is a limited amount of financial aid for the 2025-2026 school year. Only families who have registered for the 2025-2026 school year and have verified extreme financial hardship will be considered for an award. The deadline to apply for financial aid is March 31, 2025. All 2024-2025 financial aid recipients must reapply as each student is reassessed annually. There is no guarantee of award renewal. All student accounts must be paid up to date to be considered for a new award. Please visit www.rummelraiders.com to access the link to the Financial Aid Independent Review (FAIR) application.

TECHNOLOGY CHANGES FOR 2025-2026

There will also be a technology change for the 2025-2026 school year. The current Chromebooks are no longer under warranty. The school will not purchase new devices. Instead, each student will be required to purchase his own Chromebook. A list of acceptable Chromebooks and recommended purchasing sites will be provided in future correspondence. The student Chromebook will need to be brought to school on the published date and enrolled in the school's enterprise account before the device will be allowed onto the school's network. This enrollment will ensure that students have access to the same applications and services as the current Chromebooks.

A large majority of students still have a fully functioning Chromebook. Students will be allowed to continue using their current Chromebooks until the device no longer functions. When the current device no longer works, the student will need to purchase one of the acceptable devices.

FINANCIAL STANDING DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR

In order to remain enrolled the entire school year, tuition payments must be up to date. Failure to make tuition payments in a timely manner will jeopardize a student's continued enrollment during the school year.
