Dear Senior Parents,

- Graduation Practice – Thursday, May 9 – 10:00 AM – Rummel Gym
- Graduation Mass and Commencement Exercises – Tuesday, May 14 - 5 PM – Pontchartrain Center

The Senior Breakfast tickets are \$30.00 per person. Seating is limited to three (3) tickets per family – the senior, his mother and father or guardians or \$90 for three tickets. Prom tickets are \$60.00 per couple in advance and \$70.00 at the door. We will sell these tickets the night of this meeting. We ask that a separate check made payable to Archbishop Rummel High School be brought for each event or exact cash for each event.

It has been a distinct honor and privilege to work with you and your son this year. The next few weeks represent an exceptional time in your son's life, and it is a particular time for Archbishop Rummel High School as well. The Class of 2019 and each young man in the class have left a unique and indelible imprint on our school.
