Registration Information:

On the assigned registration days, each student must bring:

- 1) A completed registration form
- 2) Summer school tuition.

Archbishop Rummel students will receive their summer school permits with their final report cards.

**Archbishop Chapelle students must bring summer school permits in order to register.**

Registration forms will be accepted in the main school building.

Please enter through the breezeway entrance on the Severn Avenue side of the school.

Tuition must be paid in full at registration. Payments may be made in cash, check, or credit card.

**Tuition:**

½ credit        \$350

(Each additional ½ credit is \$200)

1 credit        \$550

1 ½ credits    \$750

2 credits       \$950

**Please note, there is a 3% processing fee on credit card transactions.**

*No tuition will be refunded after **Friday, June 2nd.***

**Classes**

Each ½ credit requires each student to attend a three and a half hour class each day for two weeks.

-Morning classes are from 8 a.m. to 11:35 a.m.

-Students receive a 10 minute lunch break from 11:35 a.m. to 11:45 p.m.

-Afternoon classes are from 11:45 p.m. to 3:20 p.m.

Morning and afternoon classes are scheduled according to the times certain courses are offered. Classes begin on Thursday, June 1st. All classes will be held on the Rummel campus.

**Attendance**

Due to the quantity of content covered and skills reviewed in each class meeting, daily attendance is mandatory. There are no “excused absences” during the summer session. Students who have issues with excessive tardiness or absences may be dropped from their courses and may forfeit academic credit.

**Note to parents: Vacations must be scheduled before or after the summer session. Assignments, quizzes and tests missed due to trips, cruises, etc. will not be made up.**

**Grades**

Mid-term reports will be distributed to students for each of their courses on Thursday, June 8th and Friday, June 23rd. Report cards will be mailed home by Friday, June 30th.
